ENERGY



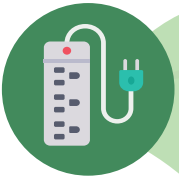
Use programmable thermostats in the office



Investigate carpool + rideshare options for your commute



Use LED bulbs for all temporary lighting



Turn off generators when not in use



Shut down computers, printers + lights at end of day



WATER



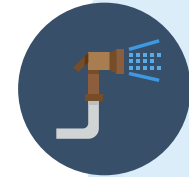

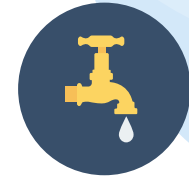
Familiarize yourself with Salmon Safe best practices



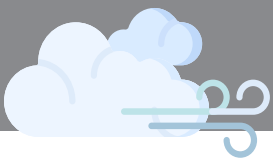
Consider Certified Erosion + Sediment Control [CESCL] training



Use closable nozzles on hoses + inspect fittings daily



Fix or replace leaking hoses



AIR



Minimize dust with prefabrication, cutting outdoors + using sweeping compound inside



Enforce no-idling policy



Keep walk off mats clean + provide boot scrapers at building entrances



Enforce no-smoking policy on site



Maintain equipment to reduce emissions



Use eco-friendly cleaning products with low volatile organic compound content



MATERIALS



Use 100% recycled material for flooring + casework protection



Use reusable water bottles



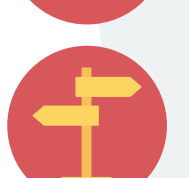
Find out if your project is going for LEED certification + ask about construction waste goals



Use tablets + reduce paper waste



Use Forest Stewardship Council [FSC] certified wood for blocking + backing



Request generic jobsite signage which can be reused on future jobs
